## Why Pray?

Are you bored yet? Is being restricted as to what you can do and where you can go starting to really drag you down? Have you watched all the old movies you can find, is Savannah Guthrie's voice starting to sound like fingernails on a chalk board? Are you tired of the president, the governor of Virginia, and even the governor of North Carolina interrupting television programs just to basically repeat what they said the day before.

Or are you hanging on every news cast, every post on the web? Are you confused by all you hear; so much counters what someone else says. There are a lot of people who are weather addicts who watch the weather channel for hours, that seems to have been replaced by COVID 19.

Anyone who has been through a hurricane can understand the addiction to the weather station. We watch, looking for the track the storm is going to take so we know what the next move is, where will we go or will we hunker down in place?

I have been through a number of hurricanes. For me I guess 1970, hurricane Celia, was the scariest. I was stationed in Corpus Christi with a training command and we had to get as many of our 60 aircraft out of harms way. I had decided we would ride out the storm. For four days before the storm hit I was watching the storm track every moment. It was just a category 3 storm, I wasn't worried and volunteered to help get things ready for the storm. I left my wife and two children at home in base housing that morning and told her if they make them move to cover I would find them.

While I was at the hanger we received word the storm was up to a category 4 and was still building. It eventually reached a category 5. I got to the shelter just minutes before the winds reached 75mph and watched the storm build. The winds got so bad that we watched as a dumpster was lifted and set right on top of a VW station wagon. When the storm had finally passed we went out and I was floored by the level of damage but unlike 17 other people I was still breathing.

As I said, I have been through a number of storms, even man made storms like Vietnam and I am still around to tell the tales. Now we are in the middle of another storm called COVID 19 resulting in a tremendous taking of lives, but it is another of life's storms. Unlike Hurricane Celia we didn't have a lot of time or any way to know the path it was going to take and precautions in advance to avoid the attack.

This virus is scary. It is something our country hasn't really faced in the past and we don't know how we are going to deal with. We are depending on the government to pull us out of this mess and the government is hardly qualified to manage the delivery of mail. We are depending on a bunch of self-righteous politicians to make us safe, that is dangerous. Then there are the protesters who want to open everything back up regardless.

There has to be a getter way to manage the issue of the corona virus other than depending on agenda filled narcissists. The virus was created by humans but there is no way humans will defeat it before many more lives are lost, not without help.
